Now the State Police have visited due to a complaint from a neighbor. This is exactly what we do not need. I suggest everyone make sure you are compliant with any Federal rules or you may be fined by a visiting officer in the future.

We intend to take steps to eliminate our problems with the neighbor. But the only way to accomplish this is for everyone to understand that FLYING NEAR OR BEYOND ROUTE 100 WILL NOT BE TOLERATED! We must all understand the gravity of our situation and police ourselves. If we continue to violate the boundaries, we will loose our flying field. No one wants that to happen.





This is a final warning to all members. If you fly beyond our boundary at route 100, you will be removed from our club. Let's all be proactive to maintain our site.
