Addendum – I'm adding this section due to recent activities at our flying field. Although we weren't aware of this at the time of meeting we have been made aware of it since. We have had a complaint lodged at the Club from the Padre Pio administration. It concerns some people or someone flying deep past the black top and nearer to the building and the parking lots of the Padre Pio facility. Keep in mind this is a place of worship for many and this will not be tolerated. Our Club also remains in the balance on this one. For now we have a new flight restriction and we can't fly over any of the black top area's. IE the entryway to Padre Pio. That includes the black top at the end of our runway. We hope to remedy this restriction to a degree to allow people ample room for landings and so on. We need to assure them first that we won't be flying close to those buildings and the parking lots. If you don't recognize members at the field make sure they have their club cards on them. At the same token if you are going out to fly have a Club Card with you. We need to enforce that non members can't fly using our field period. The Club Officers also need to be aware if there have been any complaints right away and not later. We are looking at making it easier to identify people as members. It might not be a bad idea to display your Club Cards prominently on your person to let others know your a member.

My personal favorite would be to give members a pin like a campaign button that you can pin on and identifies you as a member. Only members would be given these pins. The Club Name and the current year could also be on them. That way they expire at the end of the year. People don't always renew their memberships. Thanks Frank Dziedzic for coming up with the idea.
