

The final meeting of the club took place at Marcos Restaurant with 8 members present for the dinner meeting.

Weather permitting the club will try to have a Fun Fly on January 1st at the field, with an email confirmation several days prior to the 1st.

No other business was discussed, and the meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.
